Facts about the New School Building

- Designed by Chicago architect John Ronan, the Christ the King Jesuit College Prep's (CtK) new home is a 100,000 square foot, \$28 million state-of-the-art school building.
- Construction on the school began in late summer, 2008; Mayor and Mrs. Daley, Cardinal George and hundreds of special guests participated in the Groundbreaking in June of 2008.
- The high school, completed in late December 2009, shares the Resurrection Campus with Chicago Jesuit Academy (www.cjacademy.org), a Jesuit-sponsored middle school for boys following the Nativity model.
- While being built, CtK was the one of the largest community development projects in the Austin neighborhood. CtK provided 48 new jobs to Austin community residents through a comprehensive local employment program at the construction site.
- The new building will be open to the neighborhood for use of the computer labs, gym, and dining hall for scheduled events.
- The rooms are all named for saints of the Catholic Church and famous African-American and Chicago leaders.
- Six-hundred individuals and special guests are expected to participate in a special Building Dedication and Martin Luther King, Jr. Day Celebration on January 18, 2010.
- The architect has incorporated the most advanced aspects of sustainable design, including an environmentally-friendly "Green Roof" on entire structure which helps cool and heat the building without using energy
- In addition to 25 classrooms, each equipped with digital projector, full sound system, dvd player and wireless internet for state-of-the-art teaching, the school features:
 - St. Ignatius Loyola Chapel with seating for 210
 - Dining room which will seat 150 people and has an full, professional kitchen
 - Lobby with reception area and seating
 - Administrative offices and meeting rooms
 - 2-story gymnasium with stage and fitness room
 - 3 science labs and
 - Technology wing includes a library, group study rooms and 3 computer labs
 - Art and music facilities
 - Offices for the Corporate Work-Study Program, Campus Ministry and student government office
 - Student Counseling Suite and College Counseling Suite
